Beginning in 2015, CHF will award grants to researchers who aim to understand how to strengthen the aging dog's immune system, prevent and/or manage health problems such as degenerative cardiac disease or kidney disease, and how aging dogs can retain their cognitive function to not just live longer, but live well.
