- Motion by Don Means to delete the language in the Trust operating procedures on terms limits. Linda Taylor: Seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

- Beardie Camp 2018 Beardie Camp will be held in doors summer of 2018. We will lend our support to the Auction and other activities.
- BCCA Specialty 2017 How can the Trust be more visible at the National? Glenn and Don will speak on behalf of Trust at the closing ceremony. The Trust is supporting the Education/Health Seminar with a donation of \$1,500 and we will also make a brief presentation at that event.
